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**HEALTH EFFECTS**

**SWALLOWED:** Poisonous if swallowed. Corrosive to the whole digestive tract. May cause severe stomach pains.

<b>ENGINEERING CONTROLS:</b>	Keep workplace well ventilated.
<b>PERSONAL PROTECTION:</b>	Goggles, neoprene or nitrile rubber gloves, full protective clothing.
<b>REACTIVITY:</b>	Reacts with oxidants, halogens and their derivatives. Reacts with mineral acids and mineral alkalis. Immiscible with hydrocarbon solvents.

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**SAFE HANDLING INFORMATION**

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<b>STORAGE AND TRANSPORT:</b>	Indoors between 2.0 °C - 44 °C in plastic containers.
<b>SPILLS AND DISPOSALS:</b>	Neutralise small spills with dilute solutions of ammonia or sodium sulphite. Rinse into drainage traps. Do not discharge into waterways. Bond and soak up large spills with inert absorbents, remove and dispose of spills according to local regulations. Flush residual area and small spills with water.
